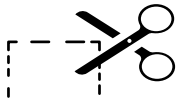

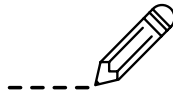

Here's how it works:



Cut out

Cut out the individual parts from the template.



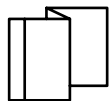
Draw

Place the individual parts on coloured cardboard, draw the outlines and cut out the parts. Make sure you make enough parts of each type, because you'll need four wheels, for example.



Cut and fill windows

Stick coloured tracing paper into the cut-out windows and surfaces of your vehicle.



Fold

Fold the cut parts along the drawn lines.



Stick together

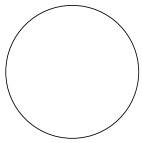
Apply glue to the areas patterned in the pattern and assemble the parts.



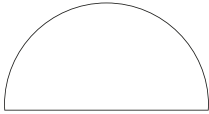
Decorate

Decorate your Unimog with the star on the hood and other details to suit your taste. Fasten your lantern light. Done!

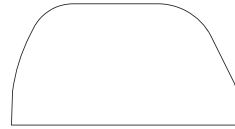

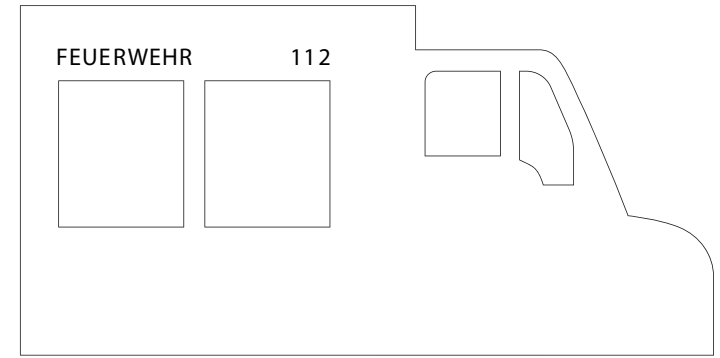
2 x rear tyre box



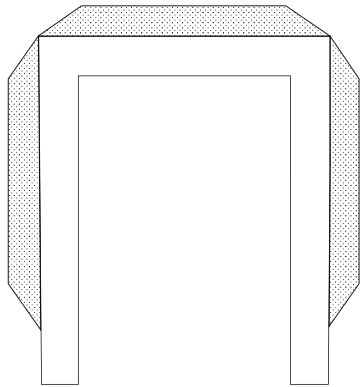
